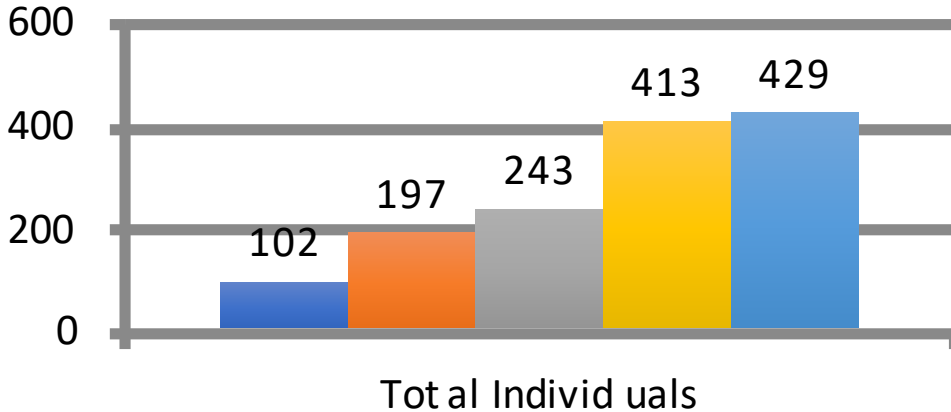

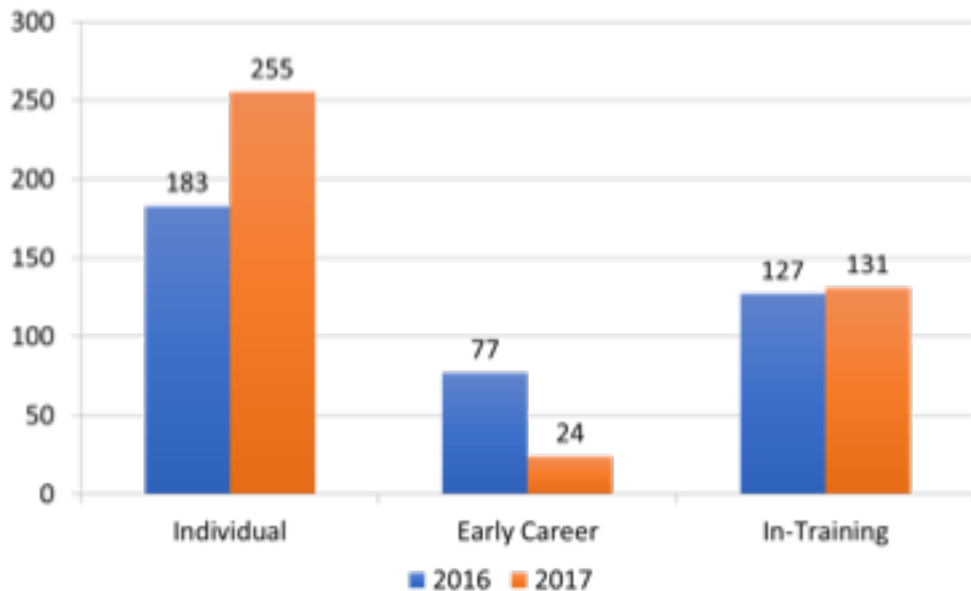

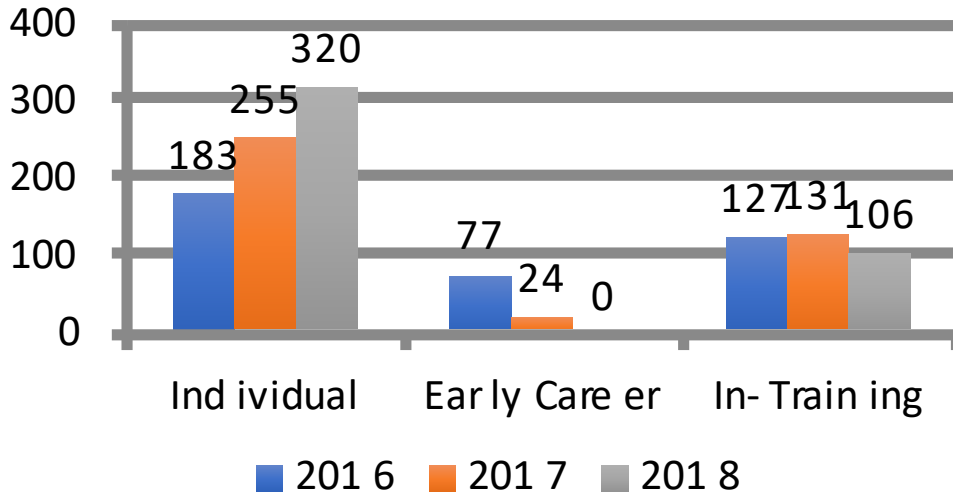

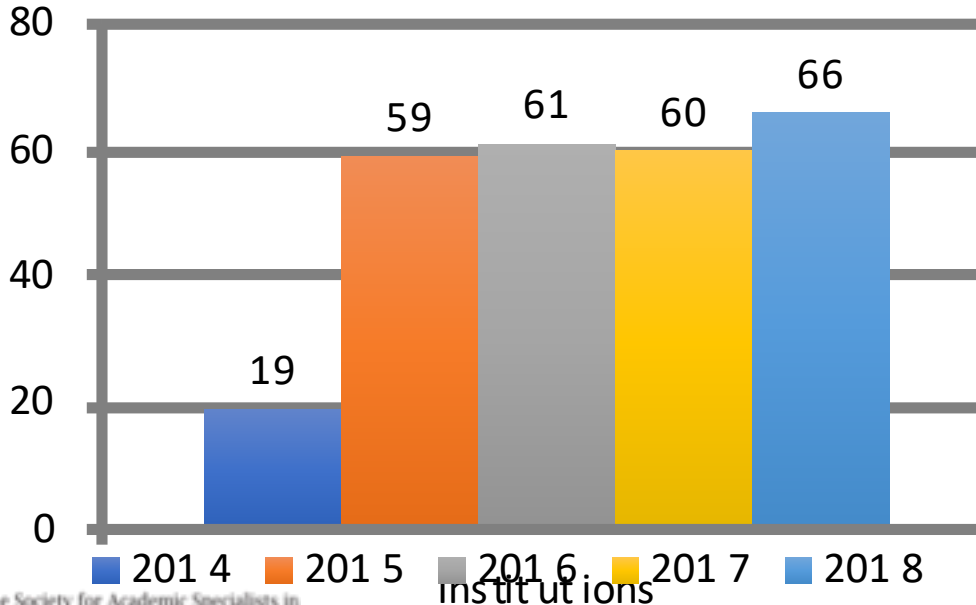

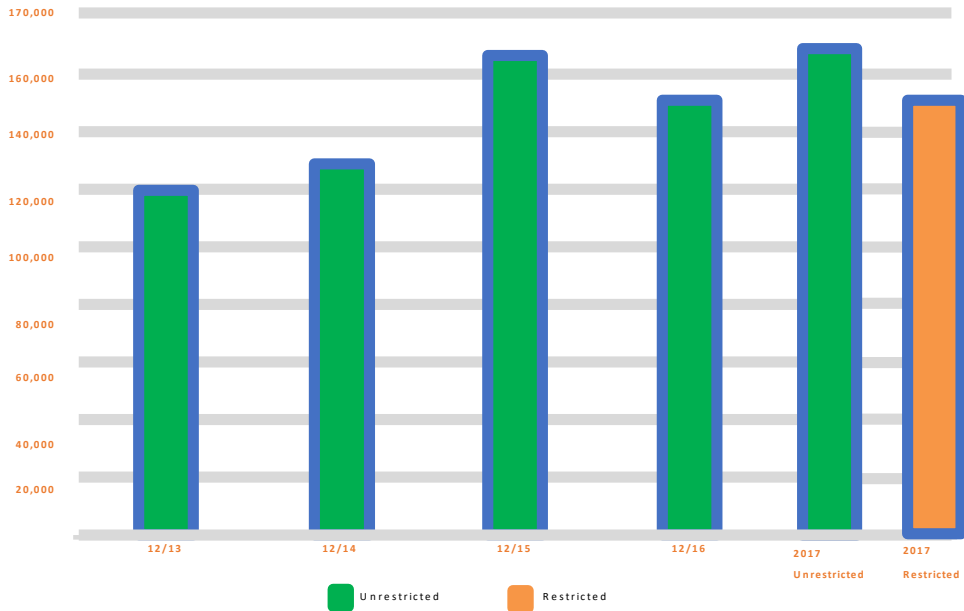

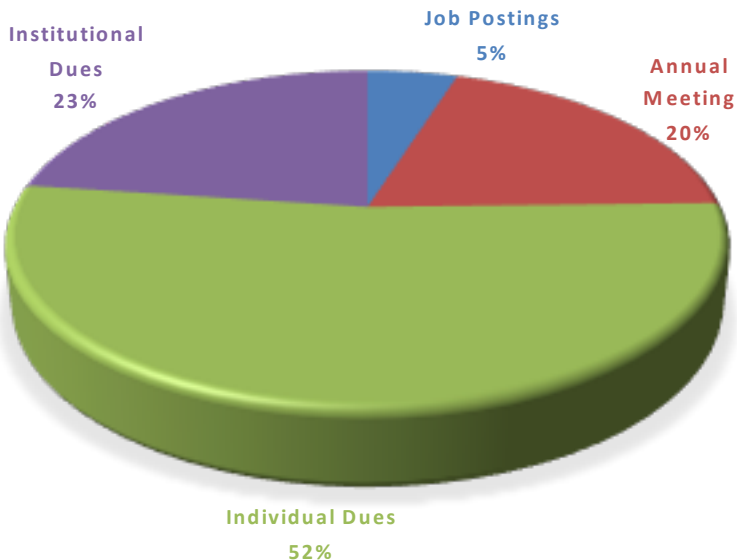

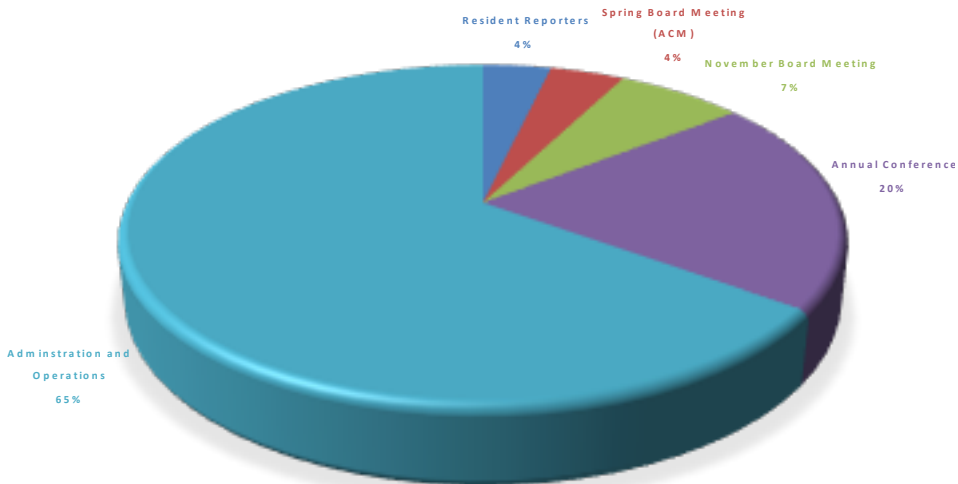
2017 UNRESTRICTED INCOME

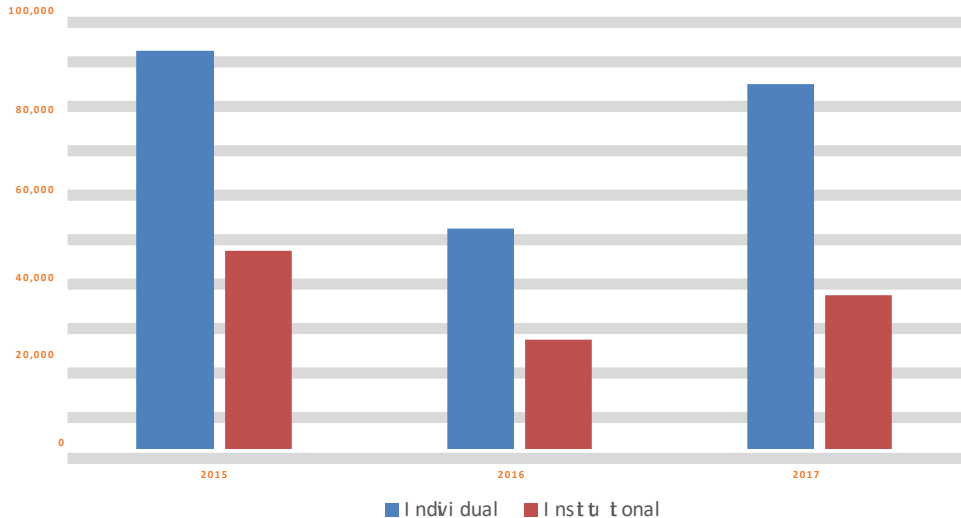
2017 EXPENSES

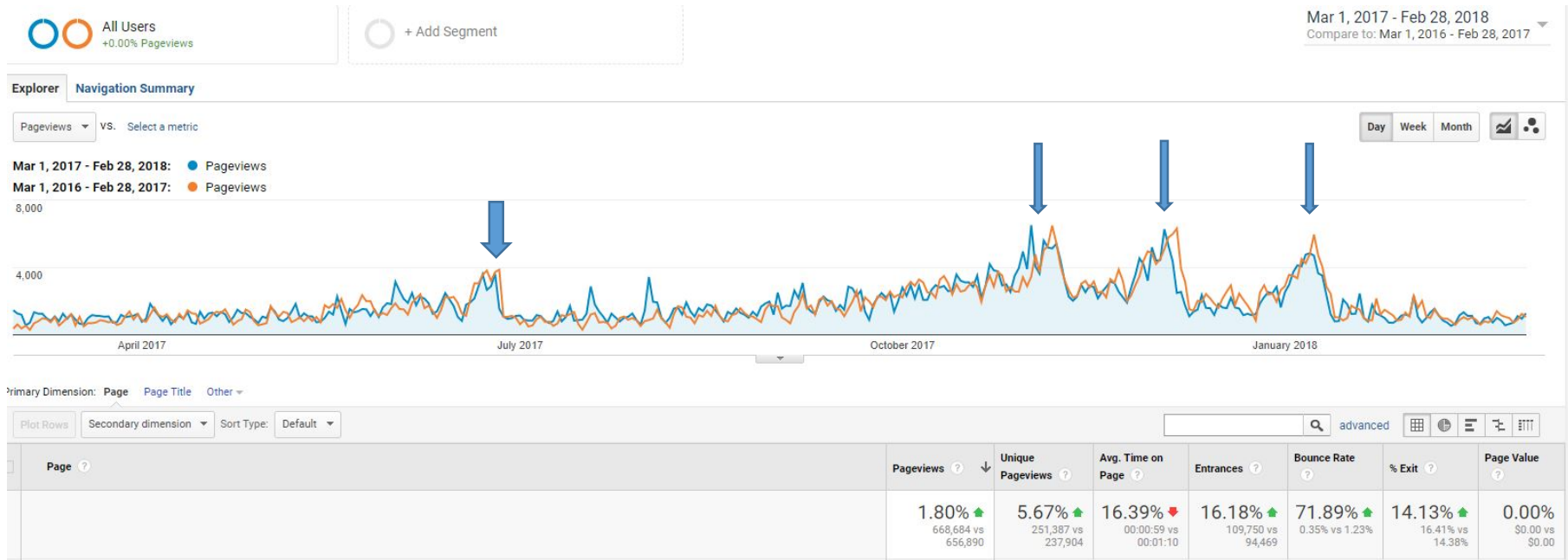

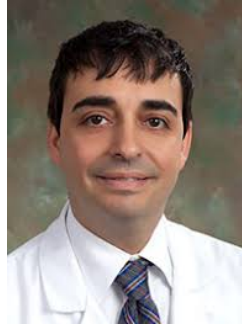

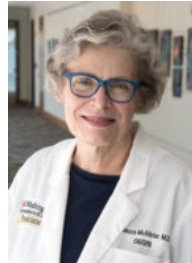
