




2017 Total Membership








2018 Total Membership






2017 Membership By Category








2017 Year-End Financial Landscape






2017 UNRESTRICTED INCOME






2017 EXPENSES



The Pearls of Exxcellence are the most challenging topics for Ob/Gyn certification. in Conjunction with SASGOG




